

MINUTES OF THE

Chairman Dwayne Sheffler called the meeting to order at 9:05 am MST on August 12, 2008. Including Mr. Sheffler, those present telephonically included Nicole Chopski, Pharm D, and Holly Henggeler, Pharm D. Berk Fraser, Mark Johnston, Mike McPeek, DAG, Kitty Gurnsey and Ellen Mitchell were present at the Board office.

The meeting is held to discuss upcoming legislation and final wording of that legislation.

In regards to Board Rules 156, 460, 187, 160, and 269, - unanimous consent granted to move forward with language presented by Mr. Johnston and Mr. McPeek.

Rule 251 regarding pharmacy technician in training – designation would begin July 1, 2009, registrants with this designation would be allowed one year from the date of issuance to complete certification requirements. Prior to July 1, 2009, the executive director may grant a waiver as to the age and high school graduate requirements. Unanimous consent granted to move forward with language presented by Mr. Johnston and Mr. McPeek.

Mr. Fraser made a motion to revise the pharmacy technician rules so the pharmacy technician registration is not pharmacy specific and does not require a pharmacist-in-charge signature. Dr. Henggeler seconded. Motion carried with quorum. (Ms. Gurnsey left the meeting.)

Rule 252 and 257 – quorum consent to move forward with language as presented.

Mr. Fraser motioned to adjourn the meeting. Dr. Chopski seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
